Jack this is the process that I follow to get an approval for landfill disposal. The entire process takes about 10 minutes. I would use this to contact every state in Region 3 and/or anywhere you will selling CIAgent. I hope this helps call be if you have questions.

1. Google the environmental agency for the respective State. Look for a section that refers to Solid Waste, Hazardous Waste, Landfill, etc. If you find one look for a contact number of any kind.
2. Call any number that you have and ask to speak to some that can help you with a question on solidified oil disposal in landfills. *You may get passed around a bit.*
3. Explain in detail that you manufacture a blend of food grade polymers that are used to clean-up spilled hydrocarbons (gasoline, diesel and motor oil) from known sources like boat bilges and that they are in small amounts of less than 5 gallons. I always explain that the polymers turn the liquid hydrocarbon into a solid rubber-like mass that can not leach, You are looking for clarification from the agency that would know if disposal of the solidified petroleum in landfills is appropriate for their State and that you have independent test data you will be submitting for their review.
4. Once you have spoken to or have the name, title and contact information of the decision maker send the the following information. Email is quicker but if send it by regular mail your answer will probably be come by mail on a Departmental Letterhead.
