Dear Mr. Koons:

This letter is in response to your letter dated February 7, 2008, regarding the proper disposal of solidified hydrocarbons from minor spills. The specific situation you are requesting clarification on involves the disposal of solidified hydrocarbons (gasoline, diesel fuel, refined motor oils) in amounts less than five gallons.

In a situation where disposal of a solidified hydrocarbon is required, a determination must be made by the generator as to whether or not the mixture constitutes a hazardous waste according to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 722.111. If the solidified material is determined to be a hazardous waste it must be managed and transported to a facility authorized to store, treat or dispose of hazardous waste. Solidified mixtures that are determined to be a non-hazardous waste may be disposed of in a solid waste landfill in accordance with 35 Ill Adm. Code 811.
