Re: Disposal of Solidified Hydrocarbons in Subtitle-D Landfills

Dear Mr. Koons:

The Department has reviewed your request for clarification on the proper disposal of solidified hydrocarbons (gasoline, diesel fuel, and/or refined motor oils) that are collected from minor spills with known sources. In South Carolina, solidified gasoline, diesel fuels, and/or refined motor oils from spills may be disposed of at a Subtitle-D landfill provided the following requirements are met:

1. The solidified waste is not hazardous;
2. The solidified waste does not contain any TSCA regulated constituent; and,
3. The solidified waste has no free liquids—passes a paint filter test.

In addition, the solidified waste is considered a special waste and therefore must meet the Subtitle-D landfill's Special Waste Acceptance Plan prior to disposal at that facility.
